Title: Public Market Center & Clock, circa 1928

Artist: Unknown

Location: Outlook Plaza Roof, between Outlook Hotel and Leland Building at Pike Street.

Description: Believe to be one of the first uses of neon in the Market.

Title: Farmers Market, circa 1930's

Artist: Andrew Willatsen, Architect (1876-1974)

Location: Above entrance to Leland Building/Main Arcade at Pike Street

Description: Constructed in the late 1930's when Market buildings were remodeled. Willatsen emigrated from Germany, worked with Frank Lloyd Wright's studio, moved to Seattle where he supervised construction of the Seattle Golf & Country Club (1908).

Title: Farmers Market, circa 1930's

Artist: Andrew Willatsen, Architect (1876-1974)

Location: Above entrance to Leland Building/Main Arcade at Pike Street

Title: City Fish Market, circa 1918

Artist: Unknown

Location: North Arcade Roof above south entrance to Market at Pine Street

Description: In 1918, due to artificially inflated prices, City established this municipally-owned fish market. Public ownership was short-lived.

Title: Loback Meat Co. Quality Always, 1975

Artist: Meyers Sign Company

Location: Main Arcade Ceiling by Chukar Cherries

Description: Meat sold from 1946–1989. One of several butchers in the Market. Sold meat specialties such as homemade sausages, geese and luau pigs.
