Title: *Fish & Eels*, 1993-1995

Artist: Georgia Gerber

Location: Market Main Entrance, corner Pike Street and Pike Place

Description: Bronze fish and eels wind around pillars recognizing donors to the Pike Place Market Foundation. Fish represent \$10,000 - \$25,000 contributions. Eels represent \$100,000 - \$250,000 contributions. www.georgiagerber.com

Title: *Rachel's Hoofprints*, 1993-1995

Artist: Georgia Gerber

Location: Market Main entrance, corner Pike Street and Pike Place.

Description: Bronze 4 inch pig hoofprints covering 30 feet of sidewalk recognizing \$1,000 donors to Pike Place Market Foundation. www.georgiagerber.com

Title: *Haiku*, circa early 1990's

Artist: David Wright

Location: Pike Street and 1st Avenue, embedded in northeast sidewalk

Description: Memorial to Drake Saladay, the original Flower Shop owner on the corner of Pike Street and 1st Avenue. His favorite tree, the Katsura, is represented in the plaque. Artist was the Market Foundation's first board president and leader in Market's 1970 renovation.
