**Title:** *Market Found Objects*, circa 1979

**Artist:** Paul Douglas Conrad

**Location:** Main Arcade, above garbage elevator

**Description:** Collage of collected objects found throughout the market. Artist was a 20-year-old art student at Cornish College for the Arts when he won, with this collage, a city-wide art competition sponsored by the Seattle Art Commission.

**Description:** Tile and acrylic paint.

**Location:** Market Main Entrance, corner Pike Street & Pike Place

**Description:** Porcelain enamel panels. Originally created as paper cuttings. Artist was commissioned by Japanese-American Citizen League/Seattle Chapter to create artwork honoring the memory of long-time Japanese-American farmers who were interned during WWII and never returned to the Market.
